RULES AND REGULATIONS

of the "Tuymaada" International Olympiad for Secondary School Students in 2020

- These regulations are the rules for the Tuymaada International Olympiad for Secondary school students in 2020 (hereinafter Olympiad) designed to uphold the health and safety of the participants and prevent further spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus infection.
- The existing regulations of the Tuymaada International Olympiad for Secondary school students in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Informatics, approved by the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) on March 9, 2017 No.01-09/299, do not apply to the current procedures and organizational issues.
- 3. Olympiad is the Mathematics competition.
- 4. Olympiad is a purely virtual event due to the COVID-19 pandemic with the remote control systems applied:
 - i. Competitions are held using a proctoring invigilation system;
 - ii. non-competitive events (the Opening as well as the Closing ceremonies, seminars, etc.) are held using Zoom video conferencing service, Instagram, Facebook, YouTube, etc.
- 5. Official languages: Russian and English.
- 6. Olympiad is for two age groups of students:
 - junior league students who graduated in the current calendar year, 9th grades (or less) of general educational organizations of the Russian Federation and (or) similar organizations of secondary general education of countries of the near and far abroad;
 - ii. senior league students who graduated in the current calendar year, 10-12th grades of general educational organizations of the Russian Federation, and (or) similar organizations of secondary general education of the near and far abroad. Younger participants can also participate (if there is such will) in the senior league.

- 7. Olympiad's duration is two full days. Participants will solve four problems per day in 5 astronomical hours.
- 8. Olympiad procedure for the participants formation:
 - persons and organizations are to apply for participation until September 20, 2020, in the prescribed form by email: tuymaada2017@mail.ru. The application form is posted on the official website of the organizer at http://tuymaada.lensky-kray.ru/
 - ii. Organizing committee considers applications and sends an invitation indicating the list of students invited to participate in the Olympiad by September 27, 2020.
 - iii. persons who received an invitation are registered electronically using the link specified in the invitation by September 27, 2020.
- 9. Organizing committee of the Olympiad has the right to limit the number of participants representing a foreign country or regions of the Russian Federation.
- Registration fee is 3000 Russian rubles for the participants from the Russian Federation. For participants from foreign countries, the registration fee is 100 US dollars.
