The Mikhail Alekseev International Tuymaada Olympiad in Math, Physics, Chemistry and Informatics

In 1994 the first President of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) His Excellency Mikhail Nikolaev signed the “Odarennye deti” (“Gifted children”) Presidential Program paving a way to the inception of the the International Tuymaada Olympiad for school students in Math, Physics, Chemistry and Informatics (ITO).



ITO annually invites school student from different regions of the Russian Federation and countries near and far abroad ever since.

ITO organizers are the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), the Maksim Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University, the Sakha Science Academy, the S.N.Donskoi-II Education Development and Advanced Teracher Training Institute, the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Sakha(Yakutia).



ITO’s goals are the facilitation of the development of the intellectual potential in school student and youth, the popularization of fundamental sciences, the promotion of international cooperation and communication.




